I give and bequeath unto Mary Etheredge five Barrells Corn &
one barrell pease two wheels and one Lume & one tied &
furniture one pater dish & three plates one baron & trumpet one
Cane and Call and two hoppers two sheep and two black bees to
her and her heirs for ever four Luge Hogs two sows & piggs
one Mare and Calf for the use of the plantation not to go of
them I give and bequeath unto Thedre Old all the Remainder
Part of my Estate Real and personal without doors &
within doors After all my just Debts is fully paid
and my funeral Charges paid I also Appoint Thedre
Old my sole and sole Executor of this my Last will
and testament Revoking and Disannulling all writing
or wills whatsoever made don or Acted before by me
giving under my hand and fixed my seal this fifteen
th day of January one thousand seven hundred
Ninety
