Wherewith it hath pleased the Almighty God to bless me
with, I do bequeath it in this Manner and form as follow-
eth

I Give and bequeath to my Eldest Son, Named Absalom
Langley, my Dwelling Plantation, with all the Houses
and Orchards, and all that Appurtenances thereto belonging
to him and his heirs forever Secondly I Give and
bequeath to my Daughter Joyce Langley One Shilling, Silver
paid and Leaved out of my Estate

Witness my hand and Seal this 1st day of May 1711

bequeath to my ~~Wife~~ ^{Wife} Sarah Langley
paid and paid out of my Estate.

Thirdly the remainder of ^{all} my Worldly Estate Viz: That
including all my Negro Household Goods and Cattle and all
whatsoever was called mine both within Doors and
without, I desire and request that they shall all be sold
at publick Sale and after my Debts are paid out of my Estate
so sold, Then the remainder of my Estate, I desire should be
Equally divided Between my Dearly beloved Wife Sarah
Langley, and my Son Absalom Langley, and my Son George
Langley, and my Son James Langley and my Daughter
Rezia Langley, and my Son Moses Langley.

Fourthly and Lastly I do constitute and Ordain my
dearly beloved Wife, Sarah Langley, and Cap: James
Minnis, to be my only & Sole Executors of this my last
Will and Testament, and do hereby utterly Disallow, revoke
annull, all and Every former, ~~Testament~~ ^{Will} Wills, Legacies
bequests, and Executors, by me in any time before Named
Will and bequeathed, Ratifying and Confirming this and

so sold, Then the remainder of my Estate, I desire should be
Equally Divided Between my, Dearly beloved Wife Sarah
Langley, and my Son Absalom Langley, and my Son George
Langley, and my Son James Langley and my Daughter
Rezia Langley, and my Son Moses Langley

Fourthly and Lastly I do constitute and Ordain my
Dearly beloved Wife, Sarah Langley, and Cap^t James
Minnis, to be my only & sole Executors of this my last
Will and Testament, and do hereby utterly, Disallow, revoke
Disannul, all and Every former, ~~Testament~~ Wills, Legacies
Requests, and Executors, by me in any time before Named
Will, and bequeathed, Ratifying and Confirming this and
no Other, to be my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof
I have, sett my hand, and fixed my Seal this Twentieth day of August
in the Year of our Lord God 1742
