Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy four make this my last Will and Testament in
Manner following - Impremes. I Recommend my soul to almighty God hoping
for blessed Resurrection and life eternall thro the merits of Jesus Christ -

Item I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Apphia Woneycott all my house hold and
kitching furniture also Two negroe Men Names David and Sepia to her and
her Disposale - Item I Give and bequeath to my son Nicholas Woneycott Part
of my Lot of Land Joining John Willoughbys Forty two feet in front and forty feet back
to him and his heirs forever - Item I Give and bequeath to my Wife -
Apphia Woneycott During life the other part of my Lot of Land whereon my houses
now stands - Item I Give and bequeath to my son Edward Woneycott after
my wifes Death that part of my Lot of Land whereon my houses now stands
to him and his heirs forever - Item I Give and bequeath to my Sons
William and Matthew Woneycotts Two Lots of Land Bought of Cap^t John Smith
Joining Cap^t Paul Loyall to be Equally Divided between them & to their heirs forever
I Desire and it is my Will that the other two Lots of Land likewise Bought
of John Smith Nos. 47. and 48 Should be sold by my Executors -
witness My hand and Seal this 21st day of April 1774

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Negro Woman named Rachel also one Negro boy named Will and one Negro girl named
Abby to her and to her Disposal - Item I give to my Daughter Anne Porter one Negro
Woman named J. dy And her Increase to her and her heirs for ever -

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Woneycott one Feather Bed and bedstead -

Item I give to my Daughter Rebecca Woneycott one Feather Bed and bedstead -

Item I give to my Daughter Francis Woneycott one Feather bed and bedstead -

Item My Desire is that my Negro Man Jathman in Jail should be either sold or
shipt of to the West Indies to my Executors hereafter mentioned And the Money
Arising from the Sale of said Negro to be applyed towards the Discharging my

Debts - And Lastly I hereby Nominate my beloved Wife Apphia Woneycott
and Cap^t Mathew Godfrey Executors of this my last Will and Testaments for Me,
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand Affixed my Seal the Day and year
first before Writing -
