I Patrick Keeton of the County of Norfolk being Sick and Weak
but of perfect Mind and Memory and knowing it is appointed
for all men here to Die. do make and Ordain this my
Last Will and Testament in the following Manner and Form

First I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary One Negro
man called Dumfri Mortgaged to me by Sam^l Wilson, or if the
said Samuel Wilson retrieve the said Negro Dumfri then the
Money lent to him thereon to be reserved to my said Daughter
Mary by my Executors hereafter named But if my said Daughter
Mary Die without Her Lawfully Begotten of her own Body
then it is my Will that the said Negro or Money be reserved
and given to my Daughter Sarah — Also I Give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Sarah One Negro Woman named Joan but
if my said Daughter Sarah Die without Her Lawfully
begotten of her own Body then it is my Will that the said

Niece Joan be given to my Daughter Mary

The Remainder of my Personal Estate I give to & equally
Divided Between Mary my Beloved Wife and my two
Daughters Above Named and further it is my Will that
all my Bills and funeral Charges be paid out of my
Personal Estate last Mentioned

Further it is my Will that in two Years after my Death
or at the further Marriage of my said Wife Mary that my two
Daughters Mary and Sarah with the Legacies Above left
unto them be taken into Care of Joseph Hodges Sen. & Benjamin
Hodges Sen. & Whom I constitute and Ordain the sole Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament, Repealing and Disannulling
all other former Wills Legacies and bequests by any
Way, herefore made or bequeathed Notwithstanding
that and no other to be my Last Will and Testament
