him forever being the full of his portion. I give and bequeath to
Willis Wilson Langley my Negro Boy George to him and his
heirs forever. I give and bequeath to Capt. James Webb the follow^{ing}
that is to say, all my Household & Kitchen furniture my Bed & c^{up}
my horse, my old cow my stock of hogs & sheep, my Cart Ploughs, Axes

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and Testament in manner and form following that is
to say I give and bequeath to James Webb Jun^r the following
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live. my Negro fellows Bob and Jack, my Negro Mench
Jegg with her three children Shela, Harry & Sally all my
Books and liberty to collect what is lent out all Debts due me
that he may settle Accounts to their satisfaction to him & his
Heirs forever, being the full of his portion. I give and bequeath to
Willis Wilson Langley my Negro Boy George to him and his
Heirs forever. I give and bequeath to Capt. James Webb the follow^{ing}
that is to say, All my Household & Kitchen furniture (my Bed except
my horse, my old cow my stock of hogs & sheep, my Cart Ploughs, Axes
& hoes, my Gun my crop of Corn that is growing, my Flax & Wool, to
him & his Heirs forever. I give and bequeath to Polly Miller the follow^{ing}
that is to say my Bed, my Cow & two yearlings the Cow go by the
name of Dembie to her & her Heirs forever

I give and bequeath to W^m Elizabeth Creechmur fifteen pounds
Current Money.

"I give and bequeath to Mary Miller daughter of said Elizabeth
Creechmur. Ten pounds Current Money.

"I give and bequeath to Caleb Creechmur, my Blue cloth
coat and ten pounds Current Money.

"I give and bequeath to Josiah Strong my silver watch
to him and his heirs forever.

"I give and bequeath to Hedar Webb my shawl of three Bunkles

The remainder part of my bottle which is his I leave to be

my Blue Rug, Old Sheets and Old Bed I leave to my
Negro Manoh Pegg. The remainder of my Cloaths I leave
to my other Negroes.

All the residue of my Estate which I have not mentioned
I give and bequeath to Capt. James Webb to him and his heirs forever.

And lastly I appoint Capt. James Webb & James Webb Esq^r
to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament utterly
disallowing all former Wills made by me. Given under

my Blue Ring, Old Sheets and a Old Bed I leave to my
Negro Mench Pegg, The remainder of my Cloaths I leave
to my other Negroes.

All the residue of my Estate which I have not Mentioned
I give and bequeath to Capt. James Webb ^{to him and his heirs for ever}
And lastly I appoint Capt. James Webb & James Webb Junr.
to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament utterly
disallowing all former Wills made by me. Given under my hand
and Seal this twenty second day of September in the year
of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Nine
