Colony of Virginia (Baker) Being Sick but of perfect Memory thanks be to God and
knowing it is appointed for all men once to die therefore I make and Ordain this my
Will and Testament in Manner following (VIZ) First I recommend my soul to God
Giver of it and my Body to the Earth from whence it came and that I be buried
in a decent manner at the Discretion of my E. & F. Executors hereafter named &
what worldly Estate that God has been pleased to bestow on me with in this
World I give & bequeath in Manner following (VIZ) my said estate to be

out sufficient to exchange the same my will is that my Executors Executors shall sell as much
 of my household goods my Men and both and young house furniture and for called
 Statute, Likewise my Desire is that my Black house formerly in the Tenure of Clerk
 Guttery packet man and joining Capt. John Calvert land is sold in case my wife
 Hanamariak should not be able or of ability to maintain her self in her widowhood
 & her Daughter Mary in her Minority but if so sold from said wife to make
 a firm Deed of the same, and if not sold for the purpose aforesaid my Desire is that
 said Wife Hanamariak should have the said House During her Natural life &
 at her Decease to Decease to my Daughter Mary her heirs Executors Admin^{rs} and
 assigns forever Likewise I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife Hanamariak
 my house now Building and gardening belonging to the same as my wife shall direct for the
 same to be laid off During her Natural life and ^{at} after her Death to Decease to my Daughter
 Mary her heirs Executors Administrators or assigns forever Likewise I give and Bequeath
 the use and Rents of my Dwelling house joining Capt. James Macawells wherein I now
 live to my loving wife Hanamariak until my Daughter Mary shall arrive to the full
 Age of Eighteen Years or more particular till the Day of her Marriage which shall
 or may first happen and then to my said Daughter her heirs Executors Administrators
 or assigns forever And more particularly at my said Wife's Death I give & Dispose of to
 my said Daughter Mary all my houses out house lands and Improvements whosoever

or Assigns for ever And more particularly at my said Wife's Death I Give & Dispose of to
my said Daughter Mary all my houses Outhouses lands and Improvements whatsoever
now lying in the Borough of Norfolk or else where to her her heirs Executors or Assigns
for ever furthermore my Will and Desire is that if in Case my Daughter Mary
Should Die before she Arrives to the full Age of Eighteen Year or the Day of
Marriage as aforesaid then to Devise all my Land and Livings as aforesaid to
my Wife Hanamauah her heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns forever Likewise I Give
and Bequeath to my Loving Wife Hanamauah (one) Negro Boy named Goliath to her
her heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns forever Likewise all my Book Debts
in General I Give and bequeath to my Loving Wife Likewise my Will and
Desire is that if it Should please God to take both my Wife and Child Mary
before the Time above mentioned and they not disposing of the houses and
Land as aforesaid then my desire is that my Trusty friend George Abyron
of this Borough Should Sell at publick sale for the best price he can get
for the said Houses and Land then remaining at their deaths and to make
afirm Title to the same to the purchaser thereof and that Money arising from
such Sale to be Equally Divided between my Brothers & his Children
