last Will and Testament in Manner and Form following Viz
Imprimis I recommend my Soul to God that Gave it I do so fully hoping
that through the Merits of Jesus Christ to have a full Remission of
all my Sins; And as to my Worldly Estate which it hath pleased
God to bestow ^{up} on me I Give in the following Manner

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Nathaniel Portlock the house
I dwell in with all the out houses standing on the same half Lot
to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Charles Portlock my New
House adjoining to my New dwelling house with all the houses
standing on the same Lot to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Nathaniel Portlock my Negro
Gale Prude and Thirty pounds in money to him and his heirs
forever

Item And my Will is that after my Just Ditts be paid & Satisfied that
the Residue of my Estate be equally divided between my three Sons

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Nathaniel Portlock, Negro
Gare Prude and Thilly, I found in money to him and his heirs
Forever

Item And my Will is that after my Just Dells be paid & Satisfied that
the Rest of my Estate be Equally Divided between my two Sons Nath^l
and Charles which I give unto them and their Heirs Forever
And I appoint my Loving Brothers William & Edward Portlock
to be my whole and sole Executors of this my Last Will & Testament
to whom I give & bequeath One Guinea a Fine to buy each of them a
Ring. Ratifying and Confirming this to be my last Will & Testament
