the worldly Estate that it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow
upon me I do give & bequeath in manner and form as followeth —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Brother Butler Smith all my Estate
both real and personal of what kind or quality soever ^{that} doth or shall to
me belong to him and his heirs forever —

And for the true performing of every part of this my last Will and
Testament. I do ordain and appoint my well beloved Brother Butler
Smith my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testa-
ment. In Witness whereof. I have hereunto set my hand and
first seal at the County of Craven this 10th day of June 1753.
