Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son William Warren the plantation
whereon I now live being One hundred and fifty eight Acres to him and
his Heirs. Likewise I Give to him my Gun and Carriage Box and
Bayonet. Likewise I Give to my son William Warren one Negro Girl
Named Lucy and One pair of Millstones to him and his Heirs.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto the Child that my wife is now with Child with
let it be Son or Daughter One hundred Acres of Land that I Bought of
my Brother John Warren and Forty Acres that I Bought of Owen Hestead
be the same more or less to that and its Heirs.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my (Dearly Beloved) wife Annes Warren one Negro
Boy called James (During life and after her Decease to Return to my Youngest
Daughter Hezekiah Warren to her and her Heirs. Likewise I Give to my Dearly

Beloved wife Annes Warren one bed and furniture and one chest of
one pair of Gallies and One Clock. Likewise I give to my Daughter
Heziah Warren One feather Bed and Furniture. Two three year old
heffers to her and their Increase

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Annes Warren one negro
Grl named Sarah and my Will and Desire that it should fall to the
first Child that Lawfully comes from her Body. But if my Daughter
Annes should die without heir or Issue my Will and Desire is
that the said Negro Grl may return to my Children again

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Christian Warren One
Negro Grl named Hannah my Will and Desire is that the said
Negro Grl shall fall to the first Child that Lawfully comes from her
Body. But if my Daughter Christian should Die without heir my Will
and Desire is that the said Negro Grl should return amongst my
Children again

And Desire is that the said Negro Girl should return amongst my
Children again

Item I leave all Best of my Estate within Doors and without to be Equally
Divided amongst my Dearly Beloved Wife Annes Warren and my
Children after my Lawfull Debts are paid And I constitute and ordain
my Dearly Beloved wife Annes Warren and my Brother John
Warren to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and
Testament as Witnefs my hand and seal this 3rd day of January 1763
