Item I give to my Friend Mrs Trebell of James City County,
all my Estate both real & Personal of What nature & Kind soever that
I shall die Possessed of to be by him disposed of in Manner and
Form as followeth. First my Will and desire is that my Just De-
bts be all paid from any part of my Estate as my Executors here
after named shall think proper to dispose of for that Purpose
and when that is fully completed I give to my Dear Wife Sarah
Conbery one Half of all my Estate both real and personal that shall
~~remain after my Debts are~~ ^{all} Paid for her Life only and at her Death
to be Disposed of as my friend Mrs Trebell shall Judge most Proper
I also give my dear wife Sarah the Choice of any one Slave that I
shall die Possessed of for ever I do hereby Appoint my Loving Wife
Sarah ^{my} Trebell & my Friend Mr Richard Taylor Executors &
Executrices of this my Last Will & Testament as aforesaid
