Item } I do give & bequeath unto my Loving Wife Ann. Carney, the full Use & profits of all my Estate of what Nature it so ever for & during her Widowhood, & afterwards her Lawfull Dower, And my desire is that my Estate be not Appraised during her widowhood; & if in Case she shall Marry, all the Rest of my Estate then found (Except her Lawfull Right) to be Equally Divided amongst all my Children

Furthermore I do Nominate Constitute & Appoint William Deanes Shipwright, & Rich^d Harris Executors, of this my Last Will & Testam^t. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day & date first above Written
