the County and Borough of Norfolk being Sick and Weak but of sound
Mind Memory and Judgment do make this my last Will and Testament
in form and Manner following. — first I Recommend my Soul to Al-
mighty God who gives it to me, and what Worldly Goods he has been
pleased to bless me with, I dispose of them as follows. —

My Will and Desire is that all my just Debts and Funeral Expences
be first paid and satisfied, I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving Wife
Elizabeth Bickerdick my House and Lot I bought of James Hodges
together with my Negro Man named Boatswain with all my Household
Goods, so long as she shall live a widow, but if she shall marry then every
thing I have left her shall be divided amongst my five Children, except
my House and Lot I purchased of James Hodges to be Equally divided
between my two Sons, Richard Bickardick, and William Bickardick.
I Give my Daughter Mary Bickardick my Negro Boy named Will, and I
all the rest of my Estate to be Equally divided between my Daughter Ann
and my two Sons, Richard Bickardick, William Bickardick and

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all the rest of my Estate to be Equally divided between my Daughter Ann
Spinner, Jane Watlington, Richard Bickardick, William Bickardick and
Mary Bickardick. And Lastly I Nominate and Appoint my loving
Wife Elizabeth Bickardick and my Friend George Abyron Executors to this
my Last Will and Testament, Revoking all former Wills by me made.
