I give and bequeath unto my son William Buntin one half mill Gun and sword

I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Buntin fifty Acres of land be it more or less for ever by the land of Peter Fogden to him and his heirs lawfully begotten for ever

I give and bequeath unto my ^{son} Richard Buntin fifty Acres of land be it more or less Commonly known by the name of the Old Plantation whereon James Buntin lives on to him and his heirs lawfully begotten for ever

I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Buntin fifty Acres of land be it more or less lying on the North side of the Maine and Commonly called by the name of the Fishing Hook to him and his heirs lawfully begotten for ever my wife & my son ^{Robert} having the care of it till he shall come to the age of twenty one years

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Buntin and her heirs for ever one Negro Girl named Harmer and her increase for ever when she comes of Age or married

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Buntin and her heirs for ever one Negro Girl named Janey and her increase when she shall come of Age or married

I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Elizabeth Buntin all the estate of my Estate in Dorset and unto during her widowhood and then to be equally divided amongst all my children and ~~to~~ ^{to} my loving wife Elizabeth Buntin to be kept and sold ~~at~~ ^{at} my last will In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of Sept 1756
