I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Daugh: Lydia Garrison one Negro Boy called Harry & one Negro Girl called Bess the said Bess to one Rugg one Dutchell one pair of Hens to her & her Heirs for ever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Daughter Julian Church one Negro
Boy called Will. Bone negro Girl called Abby & a Bed & Bolster with one Rugg
one Blankett one pair of Sheets to her & her heirs for ever in

Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Son Caleb Church a Plantation
Call the Land not debaring his Mothers Share belonging to it lying in
an Island in Curacoa in North Carolina known by the Name of
Whites Island to him & his heirs for ever But if my Son Caleb should
not live to the age of Twenty one years then the above said plantation
shall return to my Son Joseph Church to him & his heirs for ever &

of any and after I die to be equally divided amongst all my Children
to them & their Heirs for ever.

Security according to Law and at her Motion the said Will is ordered to be
Recorded.

In the name of God Amen I Timothy Jew of Norfolk County being weak
and weak of Body but perfect in sense and Memory Blessed be almighty God
for it calling to Mind the Uncertainty of Life & the Certainty of Death do
make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in Manner & Form following
first & principally I recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God that
gives it & my Body to the Earth to be decently buried according to the Direction
of my Executors in honour & glory. Amen
