

In the Name of God Amen I Richard Maccoy of the County of Norfolk being
in sound Mind and Memory Do make & ordain this to be my last Will & Testament as
followeth: First I recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave
it to me: And my Body to the Earth whence it was taken to be buried by my Ex^{or} after
named, and as for my Temporall Estate that it pleased ^{Almighty} God to bestow upon me, I dispose of as follo^w.
Item I give & bequeath unto my son Richard Maccoy after the Death of my Wifeleanor
Maccoy my Land & Plantation I now live on. Also my said son Richard paying unto my
son Thomas Maccoy Ten Pounds Curr^{nt} Money when he shall attain unto the Age of Twenty
one Years to him my^{self} son ~~Richard~~ Richard and his Heirs for Ever. But if
my said son Richard shall refuse to pay the^{se} Ten Pounds to my^{self} son Thomas, then
in such Case I give the said Land unto my^{self} son Thomas & his Heirs for Ever
My Will and Meaning that my Wife live in my Mannor house & have the use of
one third Part of my Plantation as aforesaid and that she shall not molest my
said son Richard from making use of ^{the residue of} my Land & Plantation nor the house he
now hath and lives in.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Reader Maccoy my Negro Boy Attie and my long

gun & all my Cooper's Tools to him and his Heirs for ever. Tearing that my
Wife have the Use of the Negro Boy during her natural Life
Then I give & bequeath unto my Son Thomas Maccory my hand Mill after the
Death of my Wife. I likewise give him my Son Thomas my best Gun
Then I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Eliz^a Carson one Bed and one
Iron Stoll wth her Heirs for ever.

Then I give & bequeath unto my Daughter ^{Sarah Maccory} the Bed she commonly lies on to her & her
Heirs, & I then Give for the Remainder of my Estate of what Quality so ever not
before mentioned I give unto my Wife after my just Debts are paid During her na-
tural Life and for her Decease that then the Remainder to be equally divided among
all my children. And I do nominate & appoint my Son Richard & my loving
Wife ^{Ellen Maccory} my ex^{ors} of this my last Will & Testament in Testimony where of I
have her set over my hand & Seal this 23rd of March 1750.
