First. I do hereby confirm what I did in relation to my affairs before I left Europe last, and do declare that this Writing is not to alter or controul the Settlement thereof as I had before settled the same.

Item. Whereas I have lately received a Letter of Attorney in conjunction with Doct^r Archibald Campbell of Norfolk from John Burke of the Island of Granada Esq^r empowering me to Transact sundry Affairs of him the said Burke, I do therefore hereby Substitute the said Archibald Campbell and Andrew Springle of Gosport in the Colony aforesaid Esq^r jointly and severally in my stead and place; and do desire and request them to finish and complete the said Affairs in the best manner that they can.
