

1 In the Name of God Amen, I Richard Whitehurst of Saint
~~Andrews Parish~~ in the County of Norfolk in Virginia being Stricken in Years
and knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to dye Do make
and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and form
as followeth, First I Bequeath my Soul into the Hands of Almighty
God that gave it; and my Body to the Earth whence it was taken to be
Buried in a Christian like manere at the Discretion of my Executors
hereafter mentioned and for all the Worldly Estate it hath pleased
Almighty God to Bless me with I do give and Bequeath in manner
and form as followeth.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter in Law the Widow of my
Son Richard Whitehurst the previdedge of the House and living on
that part of my Land whereon my son Richard Whitehurst lived
with the Prevedges of Tending the Land and rail Timber and firewood
for the Plantations Use during her Natural Life.

Item I Give and Bequeath all the Land I hold in Norfolk County to be Equally

Divided between my Grandson Richard Whitehurst the son of my Richard
Whitehurst Deceased and my Great Grandson William Whitehurst the
son of my Grandson William Whitehurst Deceased to be equally divided
according to quantity and quality my Grandson Richard Whitehurst to
have his Part on the East side of my Land being the part whereon his
Father lived, and my Great Grandson William Whitehurst ~~to have~~ his
Part on the West Part of my Land being the House whereon I now live
to them and their Heirs forever, and my Will is that that Part of my
Land given to my great Grandson William Whitehurst shall remain in
the Possession of my Grandson Richard Whitehurst until my great Grand-
son William Whitehurst shall attain to the age of Twenty one Years
I also give unto my Grandson Richard Whitehurst One Negro Man
named Cudd and my best Bed and Furniture to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I Give unto my Grandson Charles Whitehurst One Negro Girl named
Fate to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I Give unto my Grandson Robert Whitehurst One Negro Girl named Bittie

according to quantity and quality my Grandson Richard Whitehurst to have his Part on the East side of my Land being the Part whereon his Father lived, and my Great Grandson William Whitehurst ~~to have~~ his Part on the West Part of my Land being the House whereon I now live to them and their Heirs forever, and my Will is that, that Part of my Land given to my great Grandson William Whitehurst shall remain in the Possession of my Grandson Richard Whitehurst until my great Grandson William Whitehurst shall attain to the age of Twentyone Years I also give unto my Grandson Richard Whitehurst One Negro Man named Cudd and my best Bed and Furniture to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Grandson Charles Whitehurst One Negro Girl named Fata to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Grandson Robert Whitehurst One Negro Girl named Bitter to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Grandson Simon Whitehurst One Negro Boy named Bash to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Great Grandson Charles Rudder One Kipper to him

And his Heirs forever.

I leave my Grinding Stone to remain on my Plantation for use of
my Grand Children.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Simon Whitehurst Shifty Acres of
Land the which I hold in Princeps Ann County to him and his
Heirs forever.

Item I Give my Negro ~~Wagon~~ Sam, alias Burn to my Daughter in Law
Sarah Whitehurst to her and her Heirs forever.

And for all the Remaining part of my Estate not before given away
I Give to be equally Divided between my four Grandsons that is to
say, Charles Whitehurst, Robert Whitehurst, Simon Whitehurst &
John Whitehurst the son of my Grandson John Whitehurst to them and
their Heirs forever.

And for the True performing of every part of this my Last Will
and Testament, I do hereby nominate ordain and Appoint my Trusty
Friends Nathaniel Tatum & Thomas Nash Junr. wholly and jointly
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I
