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In the name of god Amen: I Robt. Powys of Lincolne in Virginia,
Charles being sick and weak in Body, but God being raised of sound
and perfect memory, doe make and ordaine this my last will and
Testament as followeth, First I bequeath and comitt my soule into
the hands of Almighty God my Creator, and my body to the Earth, from
whence it came to be buried in decent and Christian burryall, And
for my worldly Estate, I dispose of as followeth, Item, my debts being first
payd and satisfied I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved Daughter
Mary Powys ^{that is to say Eight Cows & Eight Storeys} in England Sixteen head of Meate Cattell, To bee Elated and
Chosen out of my whole Stock of Cattell to be delivered unto my sayd Daughter
At the end, and expiration of three yeares next ensuing after the daye of
my decease If in Case shee be then living, And shall or doe arrive in
Virginia within the termes aforesayd, and if it shall soe happen, that my
sayd Daughter shall bee living and doe not come into this Country
within the time and termes limited as aforesayd, then my will and
pleasure is, that the sayd Sixteen head of Meate Cattell, bee sold at
the best rates by outrye or otherwayes for tobacco, And if the tobacco
produced thereof, bee shipped home for England or Scotland, And

and receiveth thereof, be shipped home for England or Scotland, unto such able
and reasonable men thereof as my Executors and Administrators shall appoint
make sale thereof and convert the same into money sterling to the best
profit, and the said money to be paid and delivered unto my said
Daughter or her Assigns for her use, provided always that in case my
said Daughter be now dead, or doo depart this Life before the aforesaid
term of three years be expired, then my will and pleasure is that my
beloved Sonne Lth. Henry shall have and enjoy all the said Eight cows and
Eight Steers with their calves wholly and solely to himselfe, and in the interim
enjoy the benefit of the milke and increase of the said Eight Cows for his
Cure and payne in keeping looking to and preserving the said Sixteen horses
of Gattell, &c. I give and bequeath unto my Loving Kinsman John Rich
a token of my love One good hogthead of Tobacco and Cask and three Barrells
of Indian Corn to be paid and delivered unto y^e John Rich within one
month after my decease all the house of Corvosh Yardly. &c. I give and
bequeath unto Katherine the wife of James Phillipps for token of my love, and
for her great payne and care in tending and looking to me in the time of
my sickness One two yeare out Leyfer to be paid and delivered unto her
the said Katherine by the first of March next ensuing my decease and three
barrells of Corn present downe, and for all and singular my other Estate
of what kinde nature and quality for ever I give it wholly and solely unto my
beloved Sonne Lth. Henry, And of this my last will and testament I give
and ordaine my said beloved Sonne my whole and sole Executor,

profit, and the sayd monyes to be payd and Delivered unto my sayd
Daughter or hier assigns for her use, provided always that in case my
sayd Daughter be now dead, or doe Depart this Life before the aforesayd
term of three yeares be Expyred, then my will and pleasure is that my
belovd Some Lett. Wyls, shall have and enjoy all the sayd Eight Cows and
Eight Steers with there calves wholly and solely for himselfe, and in the interim
Enjoye the benefitt of the milke and increase of the sayd Eight Cows for his
Cure and payne in keeping looking to and preserving the sayd Sixteen head
of Cattle, Itt. I give and bequeth unto my Loving Kinsman John Rich all
a token of my love One good hoghead of Tobacco and Caffe and three Barrells
of Indian Corne to be payd and Delivered unto y^e John Rich within one
month after my decease all the house of Governor Gardly. Itt. I give and
bequeth unto Katherine the wyfe of James Phillipps for token of my love, and
for her great payne and care in tending and looking to me in the time of
my sicknesse One two yeares out Layser to be payd and delivered unto her
the sayd Katherine by the first of March next ensuing my decease and three
barrells of Corne present Downe, and for all and singular my other Estate
of what kinde nature and quality soever I give it wholly and solely unto my
belovd Some Lett. Wyls, And of this my last will and testament I make
and ordaine my sayd belovd Some my whole and sole Executor,
and Lastly I do nominate And appoint my Loving friend Governor
