ing Michall Chaisups Land on Bull Run, and Six
Hundred Acres lying on the South side of Middle Island
joining Jⁿ Calwells Land Six Hundred Acres bought
of Patrick McEllroy lying on French Creek like-
wise one Bill of Sale of a House and Lot

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Kentuck in Herods Town half Acre in Lots and ten
Acres out Lots.

and Sundry Papers being in possession of Thomas
Brown at Red Stone river

one Note of Hand on Thomas Mills one Ditto on
Jn. Calwell one Ditto on William McInteer one Ditto
on William Hawkins the just sum of these Bonds I
cannot justly remember.

My Truck containing the above mentioned Papers left in
possession with Abraham Lean at the mouth of
Whealing in West Augusta in Virginia.

I do appoint my Father James Kerr in Bedford County
Pennsylvania and Thomas Brown Sr. in West Augusta
Virginia to be my lawfull Executors to this my last
Will and Testament.
