 Adah, Nancy, George, Candice, Rachel, also my handmill one half of
 John Bailey Bond also one half of a Bond in the hand of Edward ~~to~~
 one bed and Woultles mat & cord one sheet & blanket to her and her heirs

Also I give to my Daughter in law Anne Watson Twenty Shillings
 Lastly The Remainder of my estate not already given to be equally
 divided between my Children Lovable Watson, Elizabeth William
 and Pricilla Garrison

 Jonathan Garrison Executors of this my last will in Witness where

Lastly the Remainder of my estate not already given to be equally

divided between my Children Lovable Watson, Elisabeth William
and Priscilla Garrison
