

In the Name of God Amen the <sup>th</sup> 13 day of May in the Year of  
our Lord 1760 I Robert Webb of Eliz<sup>a</sup> River Norfolk County Virginia  
being in sound Mind and Memory thanks be to God for it, do make  
and ordain this my last Will and Testament in the following manner  
and form viz<sup>t</sup>

First my Will and desire is that all my just debts be paid and dis-  
charged within a convenient Time after my death.

Item I do give and bequeath unto my Wife Agnes Webb her lawfull Por-  
tion of my land and all other Estate during her natural life. And  
my desire is that she shall have her Settlement on that part of my land  
where my Son Joseph Webb lately lived, if she desires it, and to receive  
her part of the profit of my orchard at home.

Item I do give and bequeath unto my Son William Webb all my land and  
plantation to him and <sup>to</sup> his heirs of his Body lawfully begotten  
forever, and for want of such heir to the heir at Law &c. I likewise  
give unto my said Son William all the rest and residue of my  
Estate of what kind and nature soever.

First my Will and desire is that all my just debts be paid and discharged within a convenient Time after my death —  
Item I do give and bequeath unto my Wife Agnes Webb her lawfull Dower of my Land and all other Estate during her natural life — And my desire is that she shall have her Settlement on that part of my Land where my Son Joseph Webb lately lived if she desires it. and to receive her part of the profit of my Orchard at home —

Item I do give and bequeath unto my Son William Webb all my Land and Plantation to him and <sup>to</sup> his heirs of his Body lawfully begotten forever, and for want of such heir to the heir at Law &c I likewise give unto my said Son William all the rest and residue of my Estate of what kind and nature forever, (my wife's Dower then excepted) to him and his heirs forever —

Furthermore I do nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved Friends Peter Rose and Stephen Rose my Executors of this

my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof, I have here-
