Goods as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me
I Give and Bequeath them in manner and form as followeth
I Give unto my Son Richard Williamson One Shilling
I Give unto my Son Joneth Williamson One Shilling
I Give unto my Son Joneth Williamson One Shilling

I Give unto my Daughter Keziab Bowah One Shilling.

I Give unto my Son Charles Williamson One Brinded Heifer with a white Face.

Item I Give unto my Cousin Bridget Cooper one Heifer.

Item I Give unto my Brother in Law Jacob Cooper four Cows and three Calves. Likewise a Heifer and a Bull yearling and all my Household furniture.

Lastly I do appoint and Ordain my Brother in Law Jacob Cooper and my friend William Payton my whole Executors of this my last Will and Testament renouncing all other Will or Wills formerly made by me and declare this to be my last Will and Testament whereunto I set my Hand and fix my Seal this 10 day of August

1769.
