I hereby Declare that the Legacies I have Devoted to my Wife
are in full of her Powers of and in my Estate

I give to Sarah my Daughter in law five pounds Current Money a year
 time all the Remainder of any Estate not before given away I desire may be sold by my
 Executors and the Money arising by such Sale applied in Discharging my
 just Debts and the overplus if any I give to my Loving Wife to Bring up
 my Children Till they come with age. And it is my Will and Desire that if any
 of my Children should Depart this Life before they attain to Lawfull Age and
 before Marriage then the Estate & personal Estate Devise to such ^{Child or} Children ^{as they}
^{may be equally divided amongst the survivors of my Children and} their Heirs and Assigns. And I do hereby Ordain and appoint my Loving
 Wife Sarah Langley and my Friends Capt. Matthew Godfrey and Joseph Langley
 Executors and Executors of this my Last Will and Testament Revoking all former
 Wills made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my Seal this Seventh Day of February in the year one thousand seven
 hundred & seventy two.
