A.D. 1791 and Seven Hundred and Fifty Three, make this my Last Will
and Testament in Manner following —

Imprimis. I recommend my Soul to Almighty God hoping for a blessed
Resurrection and life eternal thro the Merits of Jesus Christ
Item I Give and bequeath unto my Wellbeloved Wife Ann Swiny
two Hundred and fifty Acres of Land adjoining to Toulchers House
with the Houses of Land Toulchers Included to her and her Heirs
forever

Item I Give and Devise unto my said Wellbeloved Wife the Sighors
following, Toby, Peter Tomper, George, Clara, and Sue, and the
One half of my Stock of Cattle, Sheep, Horses, Hogs &c. that I have
on my Plantation to her and her Heirs

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Charles Swiny all my

Other Lands to him and his Heirs forever

Item I Give and bequeath unto Saml Willoughby the Negroes following Simon, Stepmo, Dick, Judy, Corrinne, Rachell, Robin, Isaac, and Nigro Wench Grace, to him and his Heirs

Item I Give and bequeath unto John Willoughby the Other One half of my Stock of Cattle Sheep, Horses, Hogs &c that I have in my Plantation to him and his Heirs

Item I Likewise Give and bequeath unto my Wellbelov'd Wife Anne all my Household Goods and Furniture to her and her Heirs

It is my Will and Desire that my Monies should be Collected as soon as possible After my Death that my Just Debts should be first Paid And the Remainder to be Equally Divided Amongst my Wife and Children

And Lastly I hereby Nominate and Appoint my Wellbelov'd Wife to be my Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament
