one hundred Pounds Sterling Money to be paid by my Executors hereafter named
in full of all claims or demands either to my real or Personall estate. Item I give & bequeath
to my well beloved Cousin & kinsman Josiah Smith now in Virginia my dwelling house & new
live cow & 3^d Town of Norfolk with y^e Kitchen ware house & improvements thereon with y^e land
thereunto adjoining & belonging to have & to hold y^e house & premises to himself & his heirs
& the heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever but for want of such heirs to the eldest of his
eldest son he shall have by my Cousin Sarah his wife & for want of such a son to y^e eldest
daughter of y^e 3^d Sarah to hold to such son or Daughter by heirs of the body lawfully to be
begotten for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my 3^d Cousin Josiah Smith two hundred Poun-
nds current money of Eng^d and one hundred & fifty pounds in European Goods at home
lost & two negro men called Pollyus & London & the Land I have near Norfolk Town
joining Col. George Wintons Land & y^e Glebe Land To have & to hold y^e 3^d Money Goods negroes
& Land unto y^e 3^d Josiah Smith his heirs & assigns for ever. Item I give & bequeath to my kins-
man Samuel Smith of Lowestoft in y^e County of Suffolk in South Mitham all my lands messuages
& Tenements in Lowestoft afores^d to have & to hold the same unto y^e 3^d Samuel his heirs & assigns
for ever. I further give unto my 3^d kinsman two hundred pounds of Eng^d money to be paid by
3^d Executors. Item I give to my Cousin Sarah Fowler of Yarmouth in North Baitain eldest son
or for want of such a son to her eldest Daughter fifty pounds Sterling to be paid by My Executors
hereafter named when he or she shall attain to lawfull age untill such time I order my 3^d
Executors to put y^e 3^d Money out at Interest for his or her benefit. Item I give & bequeath to
unto my kinsman Thomas Godly 100 pounds Sterling to be paid by my 3^d Executors

Item I give & bequeath to my Cousin Sarah Hapgood one hundred pounds Sterling & also
 two Negro children called Perry & Moll to have & to hold & Negros to my Cousin
 her heirs & assigns forever. Item I give & bequeath to my Cousin Mary Landefeld
 eighty pounds current money of Virg. & a Negro Girl called Ann to her her heirs and
 assigns forever to be paid & delivered by my S^r. Executors immediately after my decease
 Item I give & bequeath unto my Cousin Margaret Landefeld one hundred pounds
 Sterling & my Negro boy called Pompey to have & to hold & Negro Pompey to her & her heirs &
 assigns forever Item I give & bequeath all y^e rest & residue of my real & Personal Estate of
 what nature or kind soever that in Brittain Virginia or elsewhere unto my Trusty & well
 beloved Friend Samuel Smith alias Samuel Coverly & my house in Norfolk Town now in
 the Possession & occupation of M^r. Tife & y^e Storehouse adjoining to it & y^e kitchen with y^e houses
 called by y^e name of y^e Long house & all y^e Land belonging to y^e S^r. House & y^e Land where
 William Box now lives & y^e house & Land where Martha Coverly now lives after her
 decease To hold unto y^e S^r. Samuel Smith alias Coverly to him & y^e heirs of his body lawfully
 begotten forever. Item I further give & bequeath to y^e S^r. Samuel Smith alias Coverly y^e
 Land bought of M^r. Thomas Scott & M^r. John Nicholls being their wives parts of Richard Smiths
 Land on y^e Southern Branch of Elizabeth River and also my Lot of Land at y^e Great Bridge
 in Norfolk County adjoining to a piece or lot of Land of Col. Samuel Bouffes & William Menner

 Negros hereinbefore devised unto him untill he attain the age of twenty two years and in case

my & Friend Samuel Smith shall step before he attains y^e age of twenty two years then
