County and Borough of Norfolk, Merchant, being of perfect Mind and
Memory thanks be to God for the same, do make this my last Will
and Testament, that is to say, First and principal of all I give my
Soul to Almighty God who gave it me & I hope for Christ Jesus sake
he will receive it, and my Body to the Earth, to be Buried at the discretion
of my Executors, and as for my Worldly goods which it has pleased God to
give me in this World I give and bequeath as followeth.

Item I give the House and Lott I now live on with all Buildings upon the
same to my beloved Wife, Frances Calvert, during her Natural Life,
and then to my son Cornelius Calvert & his Heirs Lawfully Begotten
and in case of his Death, to the Child my beloved Wife is going with
to him or her Heirs Lawfully Begotten, but in case of the Deaths of
my Wife, Frances Calvert, my son Cornelius Calvert, & the Child
my wife goes with, then my will is, that the said House & Lott, be
Sold, & the money arising from the sale to be equally divided, between

my wife goes with, and my
Sole, & the money arising from the sale to be equally divided, between
all my Brothers and Sisters & children.

Item I give the piece of Land my Father left me joining the above Lot of
Land, giving as above and the piece of Land I bought of my Brother
Thomas Calvert which Land joins to the Land of Edward Archer, & my
Brother Cornelius Calvert to my son Cornelius Calvert & his Heirs
Lawfully Begotten but in case my son Cornelius should Die before he
comes of age, then & in that case I give it to the Child my wife Frances
Calvert now goes with, to him or her or to him or her Heirs Lawfully
begotten forever.

Item I give to the Child my wife now goes with the Lot of Land I bought of
John Smith & Joseph Hutchings in this Borough, also a piece of Juniper
Swamp Land in the said County. I give to the above Child my wife now
goes with, which together with the Land I bought of John Smith & Joseph
Hutchings, I give to him or her or to him or her Heirs Lawfully begotten
forever.

Item I give to the Child my wife now goes with the Lot of Land I bought of
John Smith & Joseph Hutchings in this Borough, also a piece of Juniper
Swamp Land in the said County. I give to the above Child my wife now
goes with, which together with the Land I bought of John Smith & Joseph
Hutchings, I give to him or her or to him or her Heirs Lawfully begotten
forever.

Thomas Calvert which Land joins to the Land of Edward Archer, & my
Brother Cornelius Calvert to my son Cornelius Calvert & his Heirs
Lawfully Begotten but in case my son Cornelius should die before he
comes of age, then & in that case I give it to the Child my wife Frances
Calvert now goes with, to him or her or to him or her Heirs Lawfully
begotten forever.

Item I give in the Church my wife now goes with the Lot of Land I Bought of
John Smith & Joseph Hutchings in this Borough, also a piece of Juniper
Swamp Land in the said County, I give to the above Child my wife now
goes with, which together with the Land I Bought of John Smith & Joseph
Hutchings, I give to him or her or to him or her Heirs Lawfully begotten
for ever.

Item It is my Will and Desire, that the House and Land in this Borough in
the Occupation of Richard Richerdike & the House and Land in the Occupation
of Samuel Skinner may be sold to pay of my Just Debts by my Executors
hereafter named. I Give and Bequeath to my Loving wife Frances

I bequeath Five Negroes to Wit. Old Sarah. Abah, Old Pathera, Caesar. If I die during her Natural Life with the Increase of them to go to my Son Cornelius & I bequeath If in case of his Death to the Child my wife now goes with, to him or her Heirs Lawfully begotten - but in case of the Decease of my Children than to my Loving Wife to be at her own disposal forever. Item I give the piece of Land bought of my Brother Thomas and the piece left me by my Father to her and her Heirs to dispose of it as she shall think proper.

Item I give to my Son Cornelius & I bequeath four Negroes to wit, Jerry, Philander, Nelepha, & Jerry's Child Lucy, with their Increase.

Item I give to the Child my Wife now goes with, three Negroes to wit Young Sarah & her Child, & Jerry, with their Increase, but in case of the said Child's Death, than I give them to my Loving Wife & Son Cornelius & to their Heirs to be Equally divided.

Item I give & Bequeath my two large Plots, to my Loving Wife & Son also. it is my will and desire, that my Sloop the Industry & Cargo, now expect

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ed from Jamaica, be sold by my Executors hereafter named with all the
rest of my Personal Estate / my Household furniture and Kitchen Furni-
ture excepted / The Money arising from the above Sales, with what
Money I may have (after my Just Debts are paid) I give one half thereof
to my beloved wife Frances Calvert, and the other to my son Cornelius
Calvert if the Child my said Wife now goes with.

Item I give my Household and Kitchen Furniture with all my Plate, & the
Use of them during her Natural Life,
but after her decease to go to my son Cornelius. if the Child she now
goes with to be Equally divided. also my Desire is that my Horses and
Mares may be sold by my Executors hereafter named.

Item I do hereby nominate and appoint my Loving Brothers, Maximilian Calvert
& Cornelius Calvert my Sole and whole Executors of this my Last Will and
Testament if I hereby revoke and make Null and Void, any Will or Wills
made concerning the above Premises as Witness my Hand this day

Item I do hereby nominate and appoint my Loving Brothers, Maximilian Calvert & Cornelius Calvert my Sole and whole Executors of this my Last Will and Testament & I hereby revoke and make Null and Void, any Will or Wills made concerning the above Premises as Witnesses my Hand this day of August 1763.
