disposing Mind and Memory do make and Ordain this to be my Last Will
and Testament in Manner and Form following.

Imprimis I Bequeath my Soul to God who gave it & my Body to be decently
Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as touching
such Worldly Goods as it hath pleased the Lord to bestow upon me I give and
Bequeath as follows to wit.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Brother John Ives my Negro Woman
& named Hannah that is to say the Use and Labour of the said Hannah for and during
the Term of his Natural Life and after his Decease the said Hannah is to go unto the
said John Ives two Sons Joel and Joshua that is the said Hannah & such Increase
as she may have after my Death & before the Death of my said Brother shall be equally
divided between the said Joel and Joshua & their Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item I Give the Use and Labour of my Negro Girl Belleford unto my Sister Elizabeth
Murray during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease.

Murray during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Girl Betteford unto her daughter Sarah Murray and her Heirs and Assigns for ever with such Increase as the said Betteford may bring.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Murray the Use and Labour of my Negro Girl named Hannah for and during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Hannah with such Increase as she may have unto my said Sisters Daughter Mary Murray & her Heirs & Assigns forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Murray the Use and Labour of my Negro Boy named Robin during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Negro Robin unto my said Sisters Son John Murray & his Heirs and Assigns for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Murry one Negro Boy named Luke that is the Labour and Service of the said Luke for and during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Negro Luke unto the said Elizabeth's Daughter Elizabeth Lidea Murray and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Murry one Negro Boy named Luke that is the Labour and Service of the said Luke for and during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Negro Luke unto the said Elizabeth's Daughter Elizabeth Lidea Murray and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

I Give and Bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Murray the Use and Labour of my Negro Girl named Hannah for and during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Hannah with such Increase as she may have unto my said Sisters Daughter Mary Murray & her Heirs & assigns forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Murray the Use and Labour of my Negro Boy named Robin during the Term of her Natural Life and ~~after her decease~~ I give the said Negro Robin unto my said Sisters Son John Murray & his Heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Murry one Negro Boy named Luke that is the Labour and Service of the said Luke for and during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Negro Luke unto the said Elizabeth's Daughter Elizabeth Lidea Murray and her Heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give unto my Sister Eloner Burges the Use and Labour of my Negro Girl Margaret for and during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Margaret with such Increase as she then may have unto
Charles

123. Charles Burges's son of my said Sister Eloner & his Heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Sister Eloner Burges the Use and Labour of my Negro Boy James for and during the Term of her Natural Life and after her decease I give the said Negro James unto Willis Burges's son of my said Sister Eloner & his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Brother John Ives one Feather Bed & Furniture Lastly I do make and Appoint my Trusty Friend David Murray and his wife Elizabeth Executor and Executrix of this my last Will and Testament to see the same faithfully Performed and I do hereby Revoke all former Wills by me heretofore made allowing this only to be my last Will & Testament.
