House and Lott, lying on the North side of Church Street near Town
Bridge and John Roberts and to her & the heirs of her Body lawfully
begotten of her Body she dying without Issue I give & bequeath it unto my
Grandson George Hensley to him and his heirs for ever.

Bed and Furniture.
