containing one hundred & five Acres with all the
conveniences thereto belonging to him and his
Heirs for ever. Then I give to my son Jock Cherry
my Land and plantation now built upon with all my
business Tools, one feather Bed & the furniture
thereto belonging to the said Bed & his Heirs for
ever. Then I give to my beloved wife Lucy Cherry this
feather Bed & furniture thereto belonging to the
said Bed that she or her Heirs for ever use
Then I give to my son Jock Cherry one large chest, to his
Heirs for ever. Then I give to my beloved wife Lucy
Cherry, one small chest to her Heirs for ever. Then I give
to my Daughter Serrow Cherry, one middle size chest
that stands at head of the bed to her Heirs for ever.
Then I give to my son Jock Cherry, one horse Pott
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wherein containing Life. Now I leave it to the
Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my
Executors hereafter named, and as touching the
disposition of all such Goods as it hath pleased God
to bestow upon me, I give dispose thereof in manner
Herein following. I give Give the right to my Son
Joell Cherry the Plantation and Land now live on
containing one hundred five Acres with all the

that stands at foot of the Bed this I give for ever

likewise three pewter Dishes three pewter plates and

the next biggest Pot, likewise three pewter Dishes &
three pewter plates this I give for ever. Then I give to

three pewter Dishes & three pewter plates one pewter
