

In the Name of God, Amen, the Twenty fifth day of January
Dom. One thousand seven hundred and eighty six I Solomon Patterson being in
perfect and sound mind and Memory, and knowing it is appointed for all Men
once to die, Do make this my last Will and Testament, and as touching my
Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with I give and
dispose of in manner and form as follows (that is to say).
Imprimis I Give and bequeath unto my Son in Law James Webb these hundred
Acres of Land commonly called and known by the Name of Ireland also the
following Negroes (to wit) One Negro Man named Toney, one Negro Man
named Stepnay, one Negro Woman named Judy and all her Increase from
the Date hereof, and also One Negro Woman named Nan and all her Increase
during my said Son in Law James Webb's Natural Life, and after his Death
then to go to my Grandson James Webb (Son of the said James Webb) to
him and his Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my friend William Smith of the Great Bridge
one small piece of Land adjoining to the Mill as follows Viz. Beginning
at a Pine in Samuel Boush's Line on the Second Island and running
from thence a Croft a Marsh to a Stake by a stump, thence to a Mark'd

from thence a Crofs a Marsh to a Stake by a stump, thence to a Mark'd
Cedar Tree, thence the same Course to the River, thence bounding on
the River to the Land of Robert Tucker's, and William Smith's, thence
binding on Tucker & Smith's Land to Sam^l Boush's, thence on Samuel
Boush's Land to the first Station to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Solomon Butt Talbut (Son of Thomas
Talbut) my Dwelling House and plantation whereon I now live, and all my
Lands thereunto adjoining, and down to the Great Bridge (only part of the
Island adjoining to the Great Bridge excepted for my Grandson James Webb
which is hereafter mentioned) And I also give and Bequeath unto my
said Grandson Solomon Butt Talbut, One Negro Boy named David One Negro
Boy named Peter, one Negro Woman named Nancy and her future
Increase ther above Land and Negroes I Give to my Grandson Solomon
Butt Talbut and his Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto Grand Daughter Suckey Talbut (Daughter of
Thomas Talbut) one Negro Girl named Hannah and her future
Increase also my Negro Boy named Jacob to her and her Heirs for ever
Item I Give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mary Talbut, (Daughter of
Tho^s Talbut) one Negro Boy named Sam One Negro Woman named

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Solomon Butt Talbut (Son of Thomas Talbut) my Dwelling House and plantation whereon I now live, and all my Lands thereunto adjoining, and down to the Great Bridge (only part of the Island adjoining to the Great Bridge excepted for my Grandson James Webb which is hereafter mentioned) And I also give and Bequeath unto my said Grandson Solomon Butt Talbut, One Negro Boy named David One Negro Boy named Peter, one Negro Woman named Nancy and her future Increase the above Land and Negroes I Give to my Grandson Solomon Butt Talbut and his Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto Grand Daughter Suskey Talbut (Daughter of Thomas Talbut) one Negro Girl named Hannah and her future Increase also my Negro Boy named Jacob to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mary Talbut (Daughter of Tho: Talbut) one Negro Boy named Sam, One Negro Woman named China and her future Increase to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Talbut (Daughter of Thomas Talbut) One Negro Boy named Jonas, One Negro Girl named Betty and her future Increase to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item

I Give and Bequeath unto my Grandson James Webb (Son of James Webb)
Part of a Island of Land adjoining to the Great Bridge, Beginning at a
Stone on the North West Corner of the said Island on or near the Main
Road, on the East side thereof, and running thence along the side of the said
Island Fifty Yards, and then with a straight line Southerly to the River
the said Land I give to my said Grandson James Webb and to his Heirs for-
ever, I likewise give and Bequeath unto my said Grandson James Webb
(Son of James Webb) One Negro Boy named Mason, One Negro Girl named
Nan and her Increase, also one Negro Girl named Wess Daughter of Judy and
her Increase, to him my said Grandson James Webb & his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Son in Law Thomas Talbut One Negro Man
named George during his Natural Life, and after the Death of my said Son
in Law Thomas Talbut, then to fall to my Grandson Solomon Butt Talbut
(Son of Thomas Talbut) to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Friend Jamima Thompson One Negro Girl
named Eddy and her future Increase to her and her Heirs forever.

Lastly My Will and desire is that all the Residue and Remainder of my Estate
within Doors and without, and what Money lies in Thomas Talbut's hands
be paid to the said Solomon Butt Talbut & his Heirs and Share

Constitute and appoint my Trusty and loving Son in Law James Webb
my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament utterly
revoking and disannulling all other or former Will or Wills by me made, Pro-
vying and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal, the Day and Year first
above written.
