2^{dly} I Give & bequeath unto my beloved Wife Martha Manning all my Corn all my Meat all my Fatt all my Bonavise & great a. & all my live Hogs of Every Sire and my frying pan & meat Sifter & all my flax & Cotton

3^{dly} I Give & bequeath unto my Son William Manning my two pewter Basons containing on pottle each

4^{thly} I Give unto my Son Tho^s. Manning one Shilling Sterling to be paid him out of my Estate if he shall ever demand it

5^{thly} I Give & bequeath unto my Son Solomon Manning all the residue & under part of my Estate of all kinds to his Disposal receiving all my Debts out of y^e same

lastly I doe Ordain & Substitute my Son Solomon Manning to be my whole & Sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament Disanuling & making void all other Wills & Testaments by mee heretofore made In Witness Whereof I have hereto put my Hand and affixed my Seal this y^e 25th Day of January 1760
