In the name of God Amen. I Solomon Nash of County of Norfolk do make this my Last Will & Testament &c. Imprimis. I give unto my Brother Thomas Nash my Land belonging to me by deed of Lease & Release which my deceased Father held & of which I gave & same To me as if I was of Norfolk County well more fully & largely appear & to him & his heirs for ever. Item. I give unto my Brother William Nash my Large Margin Bible & I also give unto my Brother William Nash my Pistols Holsters & hanger & to him & his heirs for ever Item I give unto John Mathias twelve ~~in pence~~ current Money of Virginia to be raised & levied out of my Estate & to him & his heirs for ever. Item I give unto Simon Mathias & Eleanor his Wife twelve Shillings & Six Pence current money of Virginia to be raised & levied out of my Estate & to him & his heirs forever. Item I give unto Samuel Whitehurst & Mary his Wife twelve Shillings & Six Pence current money of Virginia to be raised & levied out of my Estate & to him & his heirs for ever. Item And all the rest of my real & Personal Estate I give & bequeath unto my two daughters whether alive or dead as well moveable as things immovable both the accounts of Debts due to me as actual ready money I desire to be paid unto my two sisters that is to say Dorcas Whitehurst & Elizabeth Etheredge of y^e above mentioned Premises to go & be to the maintenance & relief of my Mother Ann Nash during her Natural Life & after her Death to be divided between Elizabeth Etheredge & Dorcas Whitehurst unto them & their heirs forever. I appoint my brother Thomas Nash my only & Sole Executor
