Give to my Wife Sarah Savells the Use of the above Negroes
during her Widowhood, I Give to my Sons James and Seth
Savells Two of my best Beds when they are of Age, the rest
of my Estate I Give to my Daughters after my Wife's Death, all
my just Debts I Leave to be paid by my Son Daniel Savells and
my Wife Sarah Savells after my Funeral Charges are paid.

And lastly I appoint my Son Daniel Savells and my Wife
Sarah Savells to be my Executors and Executrix of this my last
Will and Testament, utterly disallowing all former Wills
made

by me, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand
and Seal this 10th day of July 1768.
