

In the Name of God, Amen, I Solomon Wallis of Hagerstown
and St. Brides Parish being weak of Body but of Perfect Mind and
Memory, first I Give my Soul into the Hands of God that gave it
and my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like & Decent
Manner when my Desire is that all my just Debts to be paid then
fulfilled as followeth.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son John Wallis One hundred & Twenty
three Acres of Land lying on the S. W. side of a Branch runs out of
a Branch known by the Name of the Flat Branch, beginning at the
Mouth of the said Branch, so up the said Branch to a Marked
Hickory standing on the N side of the said Branch so along to
Marked Line to the out Line to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son James Wallis thirty Acres of Land more
or less, Beginning at the Cypress Swamp at a Marked Beach thence
running across the Plantation by a Ditch to a Marked Hickory, thence
along the Flat Branch to the Cypress Swamp again, Likewise my

running across the Plantation by a Ditch to a Marked Hickory, thence
along the flat Branch to the Cypress Swamp again. Likewise my
Will is that he shall have Liberty of fire Wood and Rail Timber of any
part of my Land, and likewise Liberty in the Cypress Swamp for
Boards or Shingles for his own Plantation Use. —

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Redar Wallis my Plantation
whereon I now live from the Ditch all the East End of my Land
Containing One Hundred and fifty Acres after the Death or Marriage
of his Mother to him and his Heirs for ever. —

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Wallis One Chest
and one Cow and Calf and one Sow and Pigg, and one Ewe and Lamb
to her and her Heirs for ever. —

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Ann Wallis one Feather Bed
and furniture, and one Cow and Calf to her and her Heirs for ever. —

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Sons John Redar James Wallis one Cow
and Calf a piece to them and their Heirs. —

Item I Leave to my Well beloved Wife Mary Wallis the Use of my
Plantation during her natural life. —

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Kedar Wallis my Plantation
whereon I now live from the Ditch all the East End of my Land
containing One Hundred and fifty Acres after the Death or Marriage
of his Mother to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Wallis One Chest
and one Cow and Calf and One Sow and Pigg, and One Ewe and Lamb
to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Ann Wallis one ~~Feather Bed~~
and furniture, and One Cow and Calf to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son John Kedar James Wallis One Cow
and Calf as price to them and their Heirs.

Item I Leave to my Well beloved Wife Mary Wallis the Use of my
Plantation during her life or Widowhood, and the Remainder
part of my Estate to be equally Divided among my five Children
that is to say, John, Kedar, James, Elizabeth and Anna Wallis after
the Death or Marriage of their Mother to be divided among them
as their Property for ever.

I do hereby make constitute, ordain and appoint my son James Wallis
my whole and sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament Disallow-
ing and Disannulling all other Wills, ratifying and confirming this
to be my Last Will and Testament Given from under my Hand and
Seal this 4th day of April 1768. —
