Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Fanny Savell fifteen pounds to
her and her Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Brother James Butte my Land to him and
his Heirs for ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to Mary Marden two Cows Halves to her & her Heirs.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Brother Wilson Butte my Bridle, saddle and
Horseshoes to him and his Heirs.

Item I Give and Bequeath my young Horse Jack to my Brother James Butte
as well as my Land to him and his Heirs for ever.

And all the rest of my Estate ungiven to be Equally divided among
my Brothers and Sisters Fanny Savell and I do appoint James Butte my
executor.

Executor of this my last Will and Testament. do Witness my Hand
and Seal this Twenty fifth day of November 1760.

thereto, And Certificate for obtaining Letters of Administration with the
said Will annexed, is granted the said Josiah Butt he having first taken
the Oath and given Bond and Security according to Law.
