

The last Will and testament of William Mosley the older
written in his own hand this 24th day of June 1655
Imprimis I give & bequeath my soule to God that gave it, and
my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my
wife and children. Item I give & bequeath to my son William
Crestall of London father of 11 years old. And to my grandchild
Carter of London father of 11 years old. Item I give unto my wife
Susan Mosley my great care and furniture, and I do
likewise give her one Negro woman called Mary with her
child 23 or 24, to be at her disposing during her life. I do
also give to my said wife all the goods & the sum of
thereof, together with all her wearing apparell, and her
life time upon the plantation where she now lieth. Item
I give to my son William Mosley Eight hundred and
fifty and being as expressed in Bartho. Rodgkins Patent.
And also I do give to my said son William one row of
foote of three months old to him and his heirs forever.
Item I give & bequeath to my son Charles Mosley all
that tract of land wth I bought of George Kemmer and more
over & above ^{that} all that land wth was surveyed to the
when I was in England to him and his heirs forever.

thereof, together with all her remaining apparel. and her
 life time upon the plantation whereof she now lives. I am
 giving to my sonne Arthur Mosley Eight hundred acres of land
 lying and being as expressed in Bartho. Hodgkins Patent
 And also I doe give to my said sonne Arthur one rowell of land
 some of these more that old to him and his heirs forever
 from my wife bequeath to my sonne Arthur Mosley all
 that tract of land w^{ch} I bought of George Kenner and more
 over a bond ^{that} all that land w^{ch} was surveyed to the Emperor
 when I was in England to him and his heirs forever. And
 for the residue of my Estate my debts being all paid
 out to be equally divided betwixt my wife Susan William
 and Arthur Mosley. /
