my Land whereon I live to him and his heirs forever.
(Item) I Give to my Son Kadah Hodges of one Moiety of that Land
own in Gibbs Neck upper part, and of Lower Moiety to my
Son Samuel part and part alike of high land and Swamp
to them and their heirs forever. — also I give to my Daughter
Ann Hodges one Negro Girl named perfecta to her and her
heirs forever, also I leave my Negro Woman Charity to
be sold to highest bidder, and the money to be equally divided
amongst my Children, that is my son Solomon, and Kadah
and Samuel, Hodges, and my Daughter Ann Hodges. These and
these alike — also I Give my Son Solomon Hodges and Kadah
Hodges, and Samuel Hodges, my Negro women named Leah
to have part and part alike in her. — and all the Residue of my
Estate to be sold, and the money to be divided amongst my
Children here named that is Solomon Hodges, Kadah Hodges and
Samuel Hodges and my Daughter Ann Hodges part and part alike.
(I appoint my beloved Brother Richard Hodges my whole and sole
Executor of this my last will and Testament.
I testify this and no other to be my last will and Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal — This twelfth day of January 1755.
