I nominate & appoint my Cozen Benjamin Miller to be my Executor of this my last Will & Testament revoking & disannulling all former Wills heretofore by me made. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fifteenth day of Novem^r

Item My will & desire is that all my Lands in Virginia and Carolina with all together with all my Negroes & other Estate of what Nature or kind I own except two Negroes called Tom & Cate which I have sold to Mr. Solomon Shepherd for thirty pounds Current Money be sold by my Executor & the Proceeds to be equally divided between my son in Law William Wright & John Gregory of Nancemond County. My desire is when

This Land whereon I now live is sold that M^r Solomon Shephard have it five Pounds
 Cheaper than any other Person. I Constitute ordain & Appoint my Son John William Wright
 of Nanamonde County my whole & sole Ex^{or} of y^e my last Will & Testament May 4th 1748

 that Plantation y^e purchased of Thomas & Mary Mason formerly belonging to Mayer
 Newton to him & y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever containing abt. Two
 two hundred Acres. I likewise give to my son William Ulegood a negro Woman named with all
 her future Increase. Item I give to my Wellbeloved Wife the house & Lott where now I live with
 all y^e out houses & conveniences thereon which I bought of Capt Solomon Wilson during the
 term of her naturall life & also that Plantation called Jones Point which I bought of Thomas
 and George Mason during her naturall life together with y^e benefit of all stock thereon
 leaving y^e Principal good at Last & after her decease I give the Lott above d^o in town &
 County to my son John Ulegood to him & y^e heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever
 Item I give to my well beloved Wife for y^e Term of y^e Years 20 y^e Phillis with their Increase & my negro man
 Prosswain to her & her heirs forever & I give to my well beloved Wife all my household
