and testiment and my worldly goods as follows

I Item I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved wife
anne Nosay one third part of my Land where
on I now live where she Chuses to take it all so
one thire part of my Lower plantation where
she Chuses to take it induring her life Likewise
Liberty to Cut timber on his land or in the swamp
for the support of her and her Children and to pay
taxes or my debts -

I Item
I give and Bequeath to my beloved son Thomas
Nosay my plantation where on I now live and my
hand mill and one feather Bed and furred tude
to him and his heirs for ever

I Item
I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved son
John Nosay my Lower plantation and one feather
Bed and furred tude to him and his heirs for ever

I Item I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved
father mary Nosay my suppress swamp and
juniper swamp one feather Bed and furred tude
one heifer to her and her heirs for ever

I Item I give and Bequeath all the Rest of my movem
ble Estate to my Beloved wife anne Nosay induring
her life and at her decesse to my Beloved father

A I do leave my two sons Lands to Be Rented out yearly and the money to Be to Good all my Children and I do here by Herokall and Gury gather will or Testaments ~~and~~ make knowne before this to Be my Last will and Testament.

I Beris I do Give and make my Beloved wife
 Anne Noyes my full and whole executor as
 beare unto This my hand and Seal this the
 fifteenth day of September one thousand
 seven hundred and Ninety
