Item I Give and bequeath to my Sister Patsia at Fairbush
two parts and that being her full portion of my Estate
And the rest of my Estate after my Debts & General Charges
is paid to be Equally Divided between my two Brothers
Wells and Moses And I do nominate & Appoint Joseph
Corbett to be my holy and sole Exor^r to see this my Will
performed In Witness whereunto I have set my hand
and Seal this Twenty fourth day of March A.D. 1853
and Seven Hundred and Fifty Three
