as I am in Right or Conscience to any Manner of Person or Persons
whatsoever, shall be well and truly Contented and paid or ordered to
be paid within convenient Time after my Decease by my
Executors hereafter named. Item I give and bequeath, in
Witness I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Sarah Wright the
Plantation whereon I now live during her Widowhood and after
her Death to my Son Joseph Wright to him and his heirs forever,
my will is that after my wife's Death or Marriage the Estate
to be equally divided to my wife and three Children, and I do
make and ordain my loving wife Sarah Wright to be my lawful
Executor.
