gives & my Body to the Earth to be decently buried according to the Direction
of my Executors in hoping of a glorious Resurrection unto the fruition of
eternall Blessings for my worldly Estate by the blessing of Almighty God I am
at present possessed with I give & bequeath as followeth.

I give and bequeath to my son James Jee one hundred acres of Land where he
now lives with some part of my plantation & twenty foot square of Land at my
landing at the Back of my House to him & his heirs for ever done Negro Woman
called Judy & one Boy called Jeffery to him & his heirs forever done Looking glass
I give & bequeath to my son George Jee the plantation I now live on & my House
with one hundred acres of Land to him & his heirs for ever done half of five to five
acres of my swamp Land to him & his heirs forever done

now lives with some part of my plantation & twenty four square of land at my
landing at the Back of my House to him & his heirs for ever done Negro Woman
called Judy done Boy called Jeffery to him & his heirs forever done Looking glass
I give & bequeath to my son George does the plantation now lived on & my House
with one hundred acres of Land to him & his heirs for ever done half of five
acres of my swamp Land to him & his heirs forever & give him my Negro Man
called Pompey & Negro Boy called Glasgow to him & his heirs for ever & give
him two feather Beds & Furniture one space Mare & half of my Cattle & my chest
of Drawers and bigish looking Glass & half of my tools & my swampy Hogs.
I give & bequeath to my son Robert does one hundred acres of Land next joining
to my son George Wisterly to him & his heirs for ever & half of my swamp Land to
him & his heirs for ever with my small House & Land at my landing done
Negro ^{Boy} called Sipio & Negro Girl called Kate to him & his heirs for ever & the
other half of my Cattle one black Mare & saddle half of my tools & two feather
Beds with their furniture two huns four sheep & my red Hogs & my oval
Table

Item I give to my son William Iow my negro Boy called Polly to him & his heirs
for ever in full for his Portion

Item I give to my Daughter Mary With my negro Woman called Jenny to her
her heirs for ever & my small horse & wide saddle in full for her portion

Item I give to my Daughter Eliza Withins one negro girl called Sue in full of
her portion & after Death to the next heirs at Law

Item I give to my Daughter Rachael Hodgins one negro girl called Nell to her
her heirs for ever in full for her portion

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Hulett one negro girl called Rose to her &
her heirs for ever in full for her Portion.

Item I give to my Daughter Affiah Iow one negro girl called Hannah
to her & her heirs for ever one Mare & both wide saddle one feather
bed & furniture.

Item I give to my grandson Willis Gregory five shillings in full for his Portion.

Item I give to my grandson Charles Iow five shillings in full for his Portion.

Item To my three youngest Children George, Peter & Anne all

I give to my Grandson Charles Doe five shillings in full for his Portion.
I give to my three youngest Children George Doe, Robert Doe & Affiah Doe
I give & bequeath all the rest of my Estate within & without in whatso ever
it may be found in & do appoint my Son James Doe & my Son George
Doe full & whole Executors of this my last Will & Testament, disannulling
all other Will or Wills made by me here before. Whereunto I have set
my Hand and Seal this Twenty Seventh day of July one thousand
seven hundred forty & three and my Will is that my Son Rob^t Doe
shall have the profit of half my Orchard for seven years.
