

To be Executors to this my last will and
Testament

January Court 1782. Proved & as of Order Book

In the Name of God Amen. I Wiltough by Old Aged Thir-
ty Eight years being of sound sense and memory but being in a
low state of health I make and constitute this my last will and
Testament revoking all other Will or Wills by me made. I trust of
me recommend my soul to the divine being which first give life
hoping thro him I shall receive his blessing for Eternal Life
and as in the Following Manner I give & bequeath my Estate in
the manner & form as follows to wit

Item I give and bequeath to my First son Thomas all one plan-
tation on deep Creek in Norfolk County joining the Land
of Cullipers of John Mansington to him & his heirs for ever

Item. I likewise give and bequeath to my said son Thomas
all the lots or lots of land that I am possessed of at the
Great Bridge to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I likewise give and bequeath to my said son Thomas
old seventy acres of land on Tumpor Swamp that was
taken up for me by my friend George D. Corpee to
him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my second son George Old the man
plantation where on my father formerly lived likewise
all the swamp land that my father bequeath me in
his last will to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I likewise give and bequeath to my second son
George Old fifty acres of land that I purchased of
Jesse Godfrey joining the lands of Willoughby Miller
& James Hodges, to him & his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Silvia Old
all the land that I am possessed of at the
Great Bridge to her and her heirs forever.

Of James Hodges, to him & his heirs for ever
Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lihoua Old
the sum of six hundred Pounds in Specie or in Negroes
To the value thereof to be paid by my Two sons Thomas &
George Old, when she attains to the age of Eighteen, or marries
To her and her Heirs, for ever

Item. As my will and desire that my Executors first pay
all my Just debts out of my personal Estate after which
said debts being paid I give and bequeath all the residue
of my Estate of every Kind such as my Negroes. Debts. ^{Gold} House
& Kitchen Furniture and every other Kind of Property
that I am possessed of, to be Equally divided between my
Two sons Thomas & George Old, to them and their heirs
Lastly I appoint and constitute my two trusty friends George
D. Cooper & Kedar Old my Executors to this my Last
Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have set my hand
and Seal this Eighteenth Day of October - 1781
