mind and Memory and being sensible of the Frailty of Human Nature
do make and Ordain, this my last Will and Testament in manner and
form following Viz: — First I leave my Soul to God who gave it me
and my Body to be decently entred at the Discretion of my Executors
hereafter named and what Worldly Estate of what kind or Nature
soever it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow on me, I Give and
Bequeath the same in manner and form following: —

- Viz My Will is and I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Son Willis Wilson Langley the Plantation whereon I now live known by the name of Bruffey back to him his Heirs and Assigns for ever. Reserving the use and Profits of my said Plantation to my loving Wife Affia Langley during her Natural life.
- 2 My Will is, and I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Wife Affia Langley the following Negroes, viz, Sandie, Anthony, Jacob, my Negro Woman named (old) Grace and Hannah and their future Increase, during her Natural life and after her decease to be given to such of my Children as she shall think proper.
- 3 I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Son Willis Langley one Negro Woman named Phillis and her future Increase. Excepting the first Child which she shall bear Male or female, which I Give to my son James. I also Give and Bequeath unto my loving Son James Langley my Plantation in Tanners Creek which was purchased of James Moore & others, and one Negro Girl named Begg, and the first Child that Phillis shall have as before mentioned to him his Heirs and Assigns for ever.

My Will is that if my Son Willis or his Heirs shall in any ways disturb

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It is my Will that if my Son Willis or his Heirs shall in any ways disturb
my Son James with regard to the plantation I have given said Son James then
and that case my Will is that my Plantation known by the Name of
Brushy Neck shall be given in lieu thereof to my Son James Langley his
Heirs and assigns for ever.

Future Increase to be Equally Divided between my Son Willis Wilson Langley
my son James Langley and my Daughter Letitia Langley, as soon as
my said Daughter Letitia arrives at the Age of sixteen years, to them their
Heirs and assigns for ever.

6 I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving Daughter Mary Langley, my
Negro Boy named Robin, Negro Boy named Happer and Negro Girl
named Estine to her, her Heirs and assigns for ever.

7 I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving Daughter Euphan Langley, One
Negro Boy named Manuel, one Negro Boy named Jeffery, and One
Negro Girl named Kate, to her, her Heirs and assigns for ever.

And my Will is that if my Daughter Mary shall die before she attains to the Age of Sixteen years, then her Negroes shall descend to Euphan, and if Euphan shall die before she attains to the Age of Sixteen years, her Negroes shall descend to Mary. I also give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary One Feather Bed and Furniture, and six large Silver Table Spoons & a Bunch Saddle. I likewise give unto my Daughter Euphan One Feather Bed and Furniture and six Silver Tea Spoons to them and their Assigns forever. I give and Bequeath unto my loving Wife Affia Langley all my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, and all my Household Furniture, and my Riding Chair, Coats, and Plantation, Utensels, with Liberty to cut and Sell Timber and Wood off the Plantation in Fanners Creek untill my son James shall attain to the age of Twenty one years. I give and Bequeath my Silver Watch unto my son Willis, and my Gun I give to my son James Langley. I give and Bequeath to my son Willis Eight Leather Bottomed Chairs after my Wife's Death, and to my son James one Looking Glass after my wife's Death. My Will is that my Negro Man Jo and Negro Woman Nance be sold, and that

my Negroes Sandy, Amos, great Robin and Jacob be hired out to pay my
Debts. I Give and Bequeath to Marian Godfrey daughter of John Godfrey Nine
pounds to Buy a Negro when she attains to the age of sixteen years.

And I Nominate and appoint my Loving Wife Affia Langley Executrix
of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my Hand and Seal this Twenty fifth Day of November One thousand
Seven Hundred and Sixty Six.
