loving wife the half my Negroes and Personall
Estate to her and her heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Langley the other half of my Land & Negroes
and the other half of my Personall Estate
former to be Equally divided between my said wife
Elizabeth Langley and my Daughter Mary
Langley if it should please god to Take my
Daughter Mary Langley out of this world
without her then my wife to enjoy all
my hole Estate both Reale & Personall and
her heirs forever

the whole Executrix of this my Last Will &
testament Revoking all Other Wills by me
Made As Witness my hand this 27th Day of
December 1753 Acknowledged to be his last
will & testament
