Norfolk County and in the parish of Portsmouth Being
Weak in body but in perfect mind and memory thanks be to God
for it do make and appoint this to be my last Will and Testament
in manner and form as followeth

Item I give unto my loving Wife Charity Jarney my plantation as

as long as she lives a Widow I also give my Loving Wife the Crop of Corn
and the pork that is for to Kill this Year and I give to my Daughter Ann Carney my Main colts at the age of Fifteen and my Desire is that Edward Moore should Keep the Colts and take care of it till my Daughter comes to that age and then my Will and Desire is that my Wife should sell as much of my Stock or other Things as she can Best spare as will pay my Debts I give to my Loving wife all the rest of my Estate after my Debts are paid as long as she lives a Widow and then to be Equally divided between my Children Ann Carney and James Carney except the Plantation and that to my son James Carney

Him I also appoint my loving Wife Mary Carney and my friend
 Edward More my whole and sole Executors of this my Last
 Will and Testament
