Anne one hundred acre of land lying and being upon Arrow-
mocal Lake joining upon the said Land I give to my Daughter
Isabell to her and her heirs likewise I give to my said Daughter Anne
Breedle two Cows and Calf in full of her Portion. — — —
Item I give to my Daughter Mary Breedle one Cow & Calf in full of
her Portion. Item I give & bequeath to my living wife Isabell Breedle

I have given and bequeath to my loving Brother Francis Bradle
the remainder part of my estate within Doors and without, like
widening Bodle and account making, and dairying, constituting
authorizing and confirming my said Brother Francis Bradle
