Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife
Phenelia, ~~the said~~ Two Negroes, Caesar
and Abby, during her Natural life, and
after her death, I give the said Negroes to
my Daughter Lurania as above mentioned
I also give and bequeath unto ^{my} loving Wife
in case my said Daughter should die before she

she arrives to the Age of Twenty One Years, or man-
One Negro Man America, together with Caesar
and Abby to her and her heirs forever, likewise
I give to my said wife One Horse, One Cow &
Calf & One Stear: all my Hogs, Sheep, House-
hold furniture and Plantation Utensils to her
and her heirs forever. And lastly I nomi-
nate and appoint my said wife, Executrix
to this my last Will & Testament. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my Seal this Seventeenth Day of
May One Thousand Seven Hundred and
Ninety One
