resely of the County of Norfolk and State of Virginia,
being of sound and perfect Mind and memory do
Make ordain and Appoint this my Last Will and Testa-
ment in manner and form as Followeth to Wit.
First it is my will and desire is that all my Just debts and
Funeral Expenses be first paid and Discharged —
Then I give and bequeath to my Mother Elizabeth Morley
one half of the house and plantation whereon, she
now Lives and also the Following Negroes Wight,
Daniel, Judy, Jerry, Nat, China, Grace, and Beulah
and one third part of all the Stock of Cattle, Sheep and
Hogs on the said plantation, and also Two Horses call-
ed Shower & Dolphin to her and her Heirs.

Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth
Morely, the other half of the house and Twenty Five
Acres of Land adjoining, being part of the Tract above-
mentioned, and a Lot or Parcel of Land at the Cross
Road, and the following Negroes (namely, Essex,
Rose, Tom, Lettice, Samueyl, Grace, and Robin
Jayork, and the residue of the Cattle sheep and hogs
Except, one Cow and Yearling) not above disposed
off and also my riding Chair and the three follow-
ing Houses, Wight Ball, Lightfoot and Bird to
her and her Heirs &c.

Item. I give and bequeath to the Child of which my Wife
is now pregnant, if a Boy, the remaining part of the
above mentioned Tract of Land not already disposed

Abovementioned Tract of Land not all ready disposed
of and also the following Negroes (Wife) Joe, Mgye
Patience, Perry, and Charles, But in case it should pro-
-ove to be a Girl then my will and desire is that the
said Land be Equally Divided between my Daughter
Elizabeth Mosely and the said child and also the five
Negroes aforesmentioned, together with the three
following Vizt, Isaac Peg and Abram to them
and their Heirs — — — — —

Item, I give and bequeath to my said Daughter Elizabeth
Mosely a piece of Land in Princeps Anne commonly call-
ed high gate, if the child of which my wife is now
Pregnant should be a Boy and also the three Negroes

above mentioned (Wife) Isaac, Peg and Abram to her, and
her Heirs. But in case it should prove to be a Girl. Then
My Will and Desire is that the said Land be Equally Divided
Between my Daughter Elizabeth and the said child as is
Mentioned in the above clause to them and their Heirs.
Item I give and Bequeath to my said Daughter Elizabeth
Norsely one Negro Boy called Adam and a young Mare
Colt to her and her Heirs.

Item, I give and Bequeath to Suky Donby Daughter
of my friend Charles Donby one Negro Girl call,
Jenny to her and her Heirs.

Item I give and Bequeath to Mrs. Lerby the Cow and
Yearling not before disposed of to her and her Heirs.

Yearling not before disposed of to her and her heirs
Her, I my will and desire is that all my household
& Kitchen Furniture be Equally divided between
my Wife and Mother to them and their heirs
Her. I give and Bequeath unto Christopher Inale
my Watch to him and his heirs

Her. I give and Bequeath to Charles Denby my
riding saddle, to him and his heirs

Lastly I do nominate appoint Mr. John Lake
and Mr. Charles Denby my whole and sole Executors
to this my Last will and Testament - In Witness
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
Twenty Ninth Day of March One thousand Seven hun-
dred and Eighty Two
