Amen And as for my Worldly Goods I Give in form and Manner as

- Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Saline (but first I have paid
back of this currency in full and no more)
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Odeon two pounds three shillings
and seven pence back of this currency and one pound half in full and
no more
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Odeon Twenty five
pounds three shillings back of this currency and one pound and half
One Wheel One Chest One Trunk One Silver Dram box One Silver Dish and
One Silver Basin
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Odeon Twenty
pounds and four shillings

My dear Mary thanks be to God for the Name and Calling to Mind that I was
born to die and full of my fleshly Nature I do here Ordain this to my
Last Will and Testament in form and Manner as followeth First I
Give and bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who

and seven pence back of this Currency and one pound half in full and
no more

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Odion Twenty five
pounds three shillings back of this Currency and one pound half
One Wheel One Chest One Trunk One Silver Draw Case One Silver Dish and
One Silver Basin

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Odion Twenty
five pounds three shillings back of this Currency and one pound half
One Wheel One Chest One Trunk One Silver Dish and One Silver Basin
Likewise I Give and bequeath unto my two Daughters Mary & Elizabeth

Odeon my Horse (called Spark) four Bags of Tanners two
Fur Coats & Shirts my Weaver Room and all the Goods belonging
thereto to be equally Divided between them both in full of their Portion
and no more

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife Patience Odeon the
Survivor of my Nigra man called Sander during her Natural life and
after her Death to return to my Son William Odeon and his heirs
Forever Likewise I Give and bequeath unto my Wife Patience
Odeon Twenty pounds both of this (currency and one of feathers bed and
Furniture to her and her heirs forever

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son William Odeon ^{my} Plantation I leave
lividors to him and his heirs forever Likewise I Give unto my Son
William Odeon all the Rest of my Estate both in Doors and out Doors
to him and his heirs forever for the Care and Charge of his Mother
During her Natural life and for the Managing of this my last Will
and Testament I do Nominate constitute Devere and Appoint my Son
William Odeon my sole and sole Executor In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal this 24th of December 1743
